Looking to donate your pet's supplies, medications, or food?

Below are compassionate organizations in New York City that accept gently used or new items to help animals in need.

General Supplies (beds, toys, bowls, leashes, towels)

Animal Care Centers of NYC (ACC)

- Accepts: Towels, beds, blankets, toys, leashes, unopened food
- Drop-off: Manhattan, Brooklyn, Bronx, Staten Island, Queens

Sean Casey Animal Rescue

- Website: nyanimalrescue.org
- Accepts: Beds, toys, food, crates, and more
- Location: Windsor Terrace, Brooklyn

Bideawee

- Website: bideawee.org
- Accepts: New/gently used supplies (call or email first)
- Locations: Manhattan & Westhampton

Medications

- Contact your veterinarian or local rescue directly—some may accept unopened medications if legally allowed.
- Medications must be in original packaging and not expired.

Unopened Food, Treats & Supplements

- Pet Food Pantries: Try local food banks (e.g., Food Bank For NYC) or search “pet food pantry NYC.”
- Some churches or shelters offer distribution to pet parents in need.
